HISTORY

The Bill Wales Memorial Trophy

This award is for Outstanding Achievement in Surf Boat. It is not awarded every year; rather it is awarded only when the achievement is considered to be Significant. Donated by the Wales Family in honour of Bill Wales, it is a scale model of a surf boat. Like all of the Wales family, Bill was a staunch and active Swanbourne member. He was a swimmer, R&R competitor and boatie, active in the 40s and 50s. Those who remember him recall that he was always friendly and helpful, particularly to the younger members.
