The award is only open to new Bronzies who had completed their Bronze Medallion in the 12 months prior to the Club Championships (or, more accurately, since the last Club Championships were held). It was felt by the Management Committee that it is hard for a new Bronze to be competitive at the Club Championships, as they would be racing against Club members with much more experience and technical ability, especially in the craft events. The New Bronze Medallion was therefore introduced to recognize the best overall novice in both men's and women's categories in a range of events that new Bronzies should be proficient at; the board race, the long swim, the long run and the run-swim-run. Congratulations to our two inaugural winners, Ryoka Elton in the Women's and Chris Donnelly in the Men's.

BY-LAWS

2.6 New Bronze Medallion Trophy

The Club shall conduct a New Bronze Medallion Trophy annually during the season.

Competitors in the New Bronze Medallion Trophy shall have been awarded their Bronze Medallion at the Club between the date of the preceding Club Championships and the date of the current Club Championships.

Competitors who have successfully completed their Bronze Medallion assessment but have not yet been processed by Surf Life Saving Western Australia shall be deemed to have been awarded their Bronze Medallion on the date of their Bronze Medallion assessment.

No competitor shall be permitted to compete in more than one New Bronze Medallion Trophy.

The list of eligible competitors in the New Bronze Medallion Trophy shall be determined by the Education Manager and nominated to the Race Officer prior to the commencement of the Club Championships.

New Bronze Medallion Trophy events shall be conducted in the following categories or as determined by the Competition Manager.

Open Male

Open Female

The New Bronze Medallion Trophy events would normally include:

Surf Race

Run Swim Run Race

Long Run

Surf Board Race

New Bronze Medallion Trophy events shall be conducted as part of the Club Championships in accordance with the current SLSA Australian Surf Sports Manual wherever possible. Any departure(s) from the current SLSA Australian Surf Sports Manual shall be determined by the Competition Manager and nominated to the Race Officer prior to the commencement of the Club Championships.

Points will be awarded in each event to determine the overall New Bronze Medallion Trophy winner in each of the above membership categories. In the event of there being a tie, the competitor who has finished first in the most events shall be deemed the winner. In the event of there still being a tie, the competitors who has finished second in the most events shall be deemed the winner and so on. In the event of there still being a tie, both competitors shall be deemed the winner.

The following points shall be allocated for all events:

1st place	12 points
2nd place	9 points
3rd place	6 points
4th place	4 points
5th place	3 points
6th place	2 points
All others	1 point.

The winners of the New Bronze Medallion Trophy shall have their names suitably engraved on a perpetual trophy.

PROPOSED

2.6 New Bronze Medallion

The Club shall conduct a New Bronze Medallion trophy event annually during the season.

Competitors in the New Bronze Medallion trophy event shall have been awarded their Bronze Medallion at the Club between the date of the preceding Club Championships and the date of the current Club Championships.

Competitors who have successfully completed their Bronze Medallion assessment but have not yet been processed by SLSWA shall be deemed to have been awarded their Bronze Medallion on the date of their Bronze Medallion assessment.

No competitor shall be permitted to compete in more than one New Bronze Medallion trophy event.

The list of eligible competitors in the New Bronze Medallion trophy event shall be determined by the Education Manager and nominated to the Surf Sports Manager or their delegate prior to the commencement of the Club Championships.

Any departure(s) from the current SLSA Australian Surf Sports Manual shall be determined by the Surf Sports Manager and nominated to the Surf Sports Manager or their delegate prior to the commencement of the Club Championships.

Points will be awarded in each event to determine the overall New Bronze Medallion trophy winner in each of the above categories. In the event of there being a tie, the competitor who has finished first in the most events shall be deemed the winner. In the event of there still being a tie, the competitor who has finished second in the most events shall be deemed the winner and so on. In the event of there still being a tie, all tied competitors shall be deemed the winner.
